Outcome of impairment review

Energy Resources of Australia Ltd (**ERA**) advises that it has substantially completed its review of asset carrying value recoverability, further to its announcement on 15 October 2015. The Company has performed the review in accordance with Australian Accounting Standards.

The outcome of the review indicates that there is currently no impairment. The assessment is sensitive to a range of factors including economic and business assumptions. ERA will continue to monitor the Company's circumstances for potential indicators of impairment prior to the announcement of its 2015 financial results in January 2016.
