ERA releases Ranger Mine Closure Plan update

Energy Resources of Australia Ltd (ERA) has released an update to the Ranger Mine Closure Plan.

The updated Mine Closure Plan (the Plan) follows the first public release of the Plan in June 2018, and subsequent updates. The Plan is updated in accordance with regulatory requirements and in consultation with Traditional Owner representatives, regulators, and key stakeholders.

ERA's Chief Executive Brad Welsh said: "This Plan demonstrates our ongoing commitment to rehabilitation and details an outline of what needs to be delivered to achieve world class rehabilitation. We have achieved good progress against our rehabilitation targets already, with the rehabilitation of Pit 1, transfer of tailings, long term research, and application of best practice science and technology. "

"I want to acknowledge our team and everyone who has worked tirelessly to deliver this. Our team are working hard to rehabilitate the Ranger Project Area, caring for country and returning the site to the Traditional Owners." Mr Welsh said.

ERA remains committed to the amendments required to the Atomic Energy Act to be passed by parliament so that Rehabilitation activities stipulated in the Plan can continue past the current prescribed date of January 2026. ERA continues to work with Gundjeihmi Aboriginal Corporation, and the Northern Land Council to jointly support these amendments.
