Ranger 3 Deeps Exploration Decline Environmental Approval Process

On 15 April 2009, Energy Resources of Australia Ltd (ERA) announced it had lodged notifications with the Commonwealth of Australia and Northern Territory governments for a proposed exploration decline project at Ranger. The project will allow ERA to conduct close spaced underground exploration drilling to further evaluate the extent and continuity of the Ranger 3 Deeps ore body, with a current resource of around 34,000 tonnes of uranium oxide.

ERA has now received notification from the Northern Territory Government that the Ranger 3 Deeps exploration decline project will not require formal environmental assessment under the Northern Territory *Environmental Assessment Act*. This followed the determination in May 2009 by the Commonwealth Government that the project was not a controlled action requiring further environmental assessment under the Commonwealth *Environmental Protection & Biodiversity Conservation Act*.
